vii) To indoctrinate the qualities and ethics of team work, leadership and self-esteem.


**3. The Context:** As an institution with a rural background and with limited resources to function, the college strives to provide and cater to the well-being of not only the learners but to the society in general. The first-generation learners in this institution struggles to come out and interact with the society at large due to lack of exposure in various social dimensions. Individuals with higher educational qualifications are intended to be part of social construction, irrespective of their specialisation. In a highly competitive world, the learners are required to fight fiercely to mark a niche for themselves and the changing world scenario is such that the skill of a person earns them a gateway to success. With this novel thought, our institution revamped the skill enhancement programmes and relaunched the programme "*Naipunya* – One Student – One Skill" as a pathway for the students to realise their potential and accomplish their dreams.

**4. The Practice:** Higher education envisions holistic development of learners within which the augmentation of the capabilities of the learners becomes pertinent. Mere acquisition of knowledge is insufficient to attain the core values of higher education. Our institution tries to enlighten the minds of the learners through activities beyond the curriculum. In this context we

attempt to equip the learner to realise their own potential and to make them industry ready. AAs such, experts from various fields like entrepreneurs, faculty members from our institution, trainers, dietitians, farmers, specialists, etc. were invited as resource persons and interested learners were given hands on training. Our mission is to ensure productive engagement of our institution in the community. This in large is aimed to inculcate value education through experiential learning. The programme has the following components:

- Ensure that each student acquires at least one skill that will prepare them to be industry ready or future entrepreneurs. The resources for this assistance will be provided by the college community and the training is completely free of cost.
- > Promoting small scale industry and home-based entrepreneurships.
- Playing the role of mediator/consultant by bridging the institution with various Govt./ Nongovernment agencies NGOs as form of collaboration, with the purpose of introducing the students to the industry.
- Enabling the learners to become self-dependent and to develop a sense of leadership, self-respect to oneself and commitment to their family and society at large.
- The workshops/training programmes are organized as per the convenience of the resource persons and the learners (equally) without disrupting their learning hours.
- After the successful completion of the workshops/training programmes, the participants are given workshops/training programme completion certificates.
- Under the aegis of IQAC, various departments, committees, clubs and cells coordinate these workshops in association with other external agencies or personnels.

The aim of the workshop is given training in bottle art, making dream capture etc. Reshma R.V. Alumni of Department of Physics was selected as resource person. She is an expert in this field. She is an entrepreneur. She also has you tube channel to display her creativity "Malus' creations". The workshop series DIY : Art and Creativity was started by an inauguration function held on 15 th July 2021 at 06 00 pm on google meet platform.



**"Umbrella Making"** - In the meeting held by the ED Club on 15/11/2021 it was decided that a Two-Day skill development training programme on "Umbrella Making" would be conducted in association with Naipunya- 2021 and IQAC, for the students of the college on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2021, at 10.00 am. Dr Manjula K G, Assistant Professor, P G Department of Commerce coordinated the programme. Ms. Tincy Raj B T was the resource person of the training programme. Students from various departments could attend the programme and were trained in umbrella making. Various groups of Students were formed to be trained. Students could sell out the umbrellas they made through this programme, to the staff members and to the other students of this college for a reasonable price. The trainer took an attractive class on this training programme and informed regarding the availability of raw materials for making umbrellas.





Krishna Kumar.P, Project Assistant on Manuscripts, Government of India explained the importance of manuscripts in the inaugural session.







**6. Problems encountered and resources required:** During the conduct of theses skill-based programmes, we encountered many difficulties and one of the major constraints was acquiring fund for the conduct of programmes as the learners were given this free of cost. The only source of income for the college is through PTA fund which is used for all the academic, administrative and miscellaneous expenses. However, the faculty members utilised the finances diligently and the available fund from the PTA. Most of our esteemed resource persons were industrious and whole heartedly devoted themselves to teach and equip our learners with respective skills. Another constraint was that of time as organizing such sessions without disrupting the hours for teaching-learning, however, we were able to manage them efficaciously. A major hurdle was the pandemic situation that rendered us helpless, as initially learners were apprehensive of learning a skill in a close-knit space, however, the classes were conducted by following all the Covid 19 protocols.

**6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:** Even though the institution has been able to conduct programmes of social relevance and engendering scientific temper, the constraints of pandemic situation, posed a real problem. Also, the lack of access to mobile handsets (in the case of economically weaker students) and network issues posed a great challenge in disseminating the essence of *Pragathi*. Lagging university examinations and unexpected schedule of the same also resulted as a hindrance to the smooth conduct of these programmes. Being a rural college and a grant-in-aid institution, funding was also a major issue.
